Opening Remarks

(1) Map development continues with the AD HOC Committee. John Fillers reported that the new map is almost finished and that the prototype is being reviewed by the graphic designer. The updated map will include four new trails: McCormick Loop, McCormick Rail Trail, Timberton Homes Trail and Oak Bay Trail.

Sub-Committee Reports

Finance

- (1)Tim R. reported that Operating funds of PLVC Trails are \$6392.08. Reserves are \$8737.54, earning \$.36 interest.
- (2) No change to LTAC (Lodging Tax Advisory Council) funding.
- (3)Total LTAC grant of \$4400 now has \$2691.24 remaining. Interpretive signs spent: \$1066.56 and Benches: \$642.20.
- (4) The amount remaining in the cemetery account is \$832.59. (Cemetery donations: \$1550; Amount spent: \$717.41).
- (5) Tim explained that in checking this month, we spent \$303.58 on refreshments. He reported that we are over budget for refreshments \$463.49 both from the Scot's broom pull party and the coffee breaks after recent Fun Days. The operating budget still has enough to cover future refreshment costs as well as supplies and repairs necessary to support both the trails building and mowing.

(6)He also reported that we have obligated 42 percent of our operation budget and we are half way through the year. We still have some materials/supply bills coming in. Our LTAC funds are obligated \$1708.76 so we have obligated 38 percent. He will submit a report on LTAC to PLVC by the 15th of the month.
